RULES.

- 1.All Ponies must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society. Registration No's to be entered on entry form.
- 2.All ponies must be shown in natural state-not plaited or clipped, except for ears, which
 may be trimmed flat.
- 3.Foals must be at least 3 weeks old on day of the show and must accompany mares into the ring.
- 4.Class 4 Lead Rein attached to noseband of snaffle bridle.
- 5. Correctly secured skull caps or riding hats to BSEN1384 or PAS015 standard to be worn
 at all times when mounted. These are also recommended in the long reining class and are
 compulsory for all children competing in this class under the age of 14 years.
- 6. Show canes/whips must not exceed 30", the wearing of spurs is forbidden.
- 7. Appropriate smart dress to be worn by all exhibitors.
- 8. Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the class being judged accompanied by £10 deposit, returnable if objection upheld.
- 10. It is the exhibitors responsibility to enter the their ponies in the correct class or classes.
- 11. All exhibitors must be ready for their class to be judged and no class will be held up for entries competing in another ring.
- 12. Miniature ponies to measure 34" and under. Standard ponies to be over 34" and not exceed 42".
- 13. The Committee reserve the right to alter/ cancel/ amalgamate any class or classes.
- 14. The Committee will not be held responsible for any accident to animals, persons or property whilst at the showground and this is a condition of entry to the show.
- 15. All entrance fees to be paid with entries.
- 16. Dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
- 17. All children at the show must be supervised at all times.
- 18. The Perpetual Challenge Cups/Trophies will only be presented to members. Non-members will how-ever qualify if they so wish by joining the SWSPG either prior to the show or on the day.
- 19.SWSPG member's cards to be carried by all members competing.
- 20. No colts or stallions to be used in Young Handler classes.
- 21. The Committee strongly recommend that all competitors ensure they have insurance in place for themselves and their animals whilst at the show ground.
