22. Driving Class - Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over driven to an Exercise Vehicle. Open to both two and four wheeled Exercise Vehicle. A Junior Whip - is a person 18 years old and under and must be accompanied by an adult.

Best Driven Exhibit Rosette to the winner of the class.

Best Junior Whip Rosette awarded to the highest placed Junior.

All Colts 2 or 3 years old **MUST** be suitably bitted and recommended that they display a Colt Badge on their bridle.

All Stallions **MUST** have an 'S' number to be eligible for entry in classes 24 - 31

Please read NEW Rule 14 before entering. It is advised to display a Stallion Badge on their bridle.

SWSPG RULES

By entering the Show, you have agreed and accepted all these rules.

- 1) The organisers of this Show have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone MUST take care to prevent accidents occurring and MUST obey the instructions of the officials and stewards.
- 2) All Exhibitors are advised to have their own Public Liability Insurance.
- 3) All vehicles are parked at the risk of the owners and the organisers will not be liable for any damage whatsoever or how so ever caused.
- 4) First Aid is limited to emergency services call out.
- 5) Objections which may only be lodged by the owner or their authorised representative must be handed to the Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the incident and must be accompanied by £20 deposit. Returnable if the objection is upheld.
- 6) No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee.
- 7) The organisers reserve the right to limit entries and refuse entry to an exhibitor without giving a reason.
- 8) This Show is also run under the rules of the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society (SPSBS)
- 9) The Judge's decision is final.
- 10) All Ponies entered must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society. Ponies full name must be on the entry form.
- 11) SPSBS Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.
- 12) 3 years old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown.
- 13) All foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the Show.
- 14) All Stallions and Colts 2 years old and over MUST be suitably bitted. They are also advised to display a Stallion/ Colt Bridle Badge.
- 15) IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION IN HAND OR RIDDEN CLASS AT AN AFFILIATED SHOW, ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER **MUST** HAVE AN 'S' NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPSBS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPSBS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION.
- 16) Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring.
- 17) There must be no colts or stallions in the Young Handlers classes.
- 18) Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or stallions in any In Hand classes.
- 19) Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years old and under MUST wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the current Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 20) Riders of all ages MUST wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the current Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 21) If a Rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring. Rider dismounted and take no further part.
- 22) Whips and canes must not exceed 30"
- 23) Mobile phones are not permitted in the ring under any circumstance.
- 24) All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 25) For the safety of spectators, especially children, the Collecting Ring area is for Exhibitors ONLY. Please adhere to this Rule.
- 26) This Show will run in accordance with any Covid Rules which apply at the time.
