SPSBS Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.

1. Young Handler 11 years old & under. Rosettes to all (entry fee £5.00)

No Colts or Stallions in this class

SPSBS Rosette to the winner of the class.

2. Young Handler 12-16 years old. Rosettes to all (entry fee £5.00)

No Colts or Stallions in this class

SPSBS Rosette to the winner of the class.

Young Handler Championship

1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 1 & 2

3. Junior Novice Pony Standard or Miniature 1, 2 or 3 years old

(not to have won a 1st prize at any SPSBS affiliated show).

All Colts 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and it is advised that they display a Colt/Stallion badge on their bridle

Rosette for the Best Yearling in this class

4. Lead Rein Pony Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over. Rider must be at least 3 years old but not to have attained their 9th birthday by the 1st January of the current year. Snaffle bridle only and lead rein to be attached to the noseband.

SPSBS Rosette to the winner of the class.

5. First Ridden Pony Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January of the current year. Shown in any suitable bridle.

SPSBS Rosette to the winner of the class.

6. Open Ridden Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over. Riders of Stallions must be 12 years old and over.

SPSBS Rosette to the winner of the class.

NEW RULE - STALLION MUST HAVE A 'S' NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPSBS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPSBS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION. Stallions MUST wear a Stallion Bridle Badge.

Ridden Championship

1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 4- 6

All Colts 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and it is advised that they display a Colt/Stallion badge on their bridle.

7. Standard Yearling, Colt, Filly or Gelding

8. Miniature Yearling, Colt, Filly or Gelding

9. Standard 2 years old, Colt, Filly or Gelding

10. Miniature 2 years old, Colt, Filly or Gelding

11. Standard 3 years old, Colt, Filly or Gelding

12. Miniature 3 years old, Colt, Filly or Gelding

Standard Junior Championship

1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 7, 9 & 11

SPSBS Rosettes to the Best Junior Standard Champion and Reserve Champion.

Miniature Junior Championship

1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 8, 10 & 12

SPSBS Rosettes to the Best Junior Miniature Champion and Reserve Champion

LUNCH BREAK

This class is not affiliated to SPSBS

13. Driving Class Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over driven to an Exercise Vehicle. Open to both two and four wheeled exercise vehicle. Junior Whip 18 years old and under must be accompanied by an adult.

Best Driven Exhibit Rosette to the winner of the class.

Best Junior Whip Rosette awarded to the highest placed Junior.

Class 13 is not eligible to compete in any Championship.

All Stallions **MUST** have an 'S' number to be eligible for entry in classes 14 - 16, 21 & 22

Please read Rule number 14 before entering.

It is advised to display a Stallion badge on their bridle

14. Senior Novice Pony Standard or Miniature 4 years old & over. Stallion, Mare or Gelding (not to have won a 1st prize at any SPSBS affiliated show)

15. Newcomer Owners not to have owned or shown Shetland Ponies for more than 4 years. Pony any age and any sex.

16. Midi 4 years old & over. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. To exceed 34" but not exceeding 38"

17. Standard 4 years old & over Geldings

18. Miniature 4 years old & over Geldings

19. Standard 4 years old & over Mares

20. Miniature 4 years old & over Mares

21. Standard 4 years old & over Stallions

22. Miniature 4 Years old & over Stallions

Gelding Championship

Highest placed Gelding from classes 7 - 12, 16 - 18

SPSBS Rosette to the Champion

Standard Senior Championship

1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 16, 17, 19 & 21

Miniature Senior Championship

1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 18, 20 & 22

SWSPG RULES

By entering the Show you have agreed and accepted all these rules.

- 1) The organisers of this Show have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone **MUST** take care to prevent accidents occurring and **MUST** obey the instructions of the officials and stewards.
- 2) All Exhibitors are advised to have their own Public Liability Insurance.
- 3) First Aid is limited to emergency services call out.
- 4) Objections which may only be lodged by the owner or their authorised representative must be handed to the Secretary, in writing within 15 minutes of the incident and must be accompanied by £20 deposit. Returnable if the objection is upheld.
- 5) No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee.
- 6) The organisers reserve the right to limit entries and refuse entry to any exhibitor without giving a reason.
- 7) This Show is also run under the rules of the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society (SPSBS).
- 8) The Judge's decision is final.
- 9) All Ponies entered must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society. Ponies full name must be on the entry form.
- 10) SPSBS Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.
- 11) 3 years old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown.
- 12) All foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the Show.
- 13) All Stallions and Colts 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted. They are also advised to display a Colt/Stallion Bridle Badge.
- 14) IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION CLASS AT AN AFFILIATED SHOW, ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER **MUST** HAVE AN 'S' NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPSBS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPSBS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION.
**** NEW **** This Rule 14 now applies to any Stallion entered in Ridden Classes. All Stallions in Ridden Classes **MUST** wear a Bridle Badge.
- 15) Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring.
- 16) There must be no colts or stallions in the Young Handlers classes.
- 17) Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or stallions in In Hand classes.
- 18) Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years old and under **MUST** wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the current Safety Standards/Specifications
- 19) Riders of all ages **MUST** wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the current Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 20) Riders of Stallions **MUST** be 12 years old and over.
- 21) If a Rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring. Rider dismounted and take no further part.
- 22) Whips or canes must not exceed 30"
- 23) Mobile phones are not permitted in the ring under any circumstance.
- 24) All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 25) For the safety of spectators, especially children, the Collecting Ring area is for Exhibitors **ONLY**. Please adhere to this Rule.
- 26) This Show will run in accordance with any Covid Rules which apply at the time.
