SPSBS Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.

SPS-BS BRONZE MEDALS – The Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society Bronze Medals will be awarded to the Champion Miniature, Champion Standard and the Champion Ridden. Pony subject to the pony being Registered with SPS-BS and the Owner/Exhibitor is a fully paid up Member of the SPS-BS. In the event of the Champion pony or Owner/Exhibitor not being eligible, the Bronze Medal can be awarded to the Reserve Champion, should they meet the Registration and Membership requirements. Medals will be awarded by the Show Secretary, upon production of a current SPS-BS Membership Card

GEMS Rosette presented in each class (1 & 2, 6 – 13) for Miniature Shetland Ponies.

3. Lead Rein Pony Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over. Rider must have attained their 3rd birthday by the day of their class and not to have attained their 9th birthday on 1st January

of year of Show. Ponies must be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle. The lead rein must be attached to the noseband only. **The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands.**

The only attachment to the saddle allowed are a crupper or handle. Reins must not be attached to the handle or saddle. The reins must be an appropriate length and not knotted together or stitched together at a shorter length.

UNAFFILIATED CLASSES

Judge – **MR. T. DEFRANCE**, Okehampton, Devon (prefix Halstock & Blackertor)

Classes 22 – 30 are Unaffiliated classes. All classes will still be subject to SPS-BS rules.
No Stallions or Colts in the Ridden Classes 22 – 25. In the In Hand classes All Colts 2 or 3 years old **MUST** be suitably bitted and recommended that they display a Colt Badge on their bridle.
All Stallions **MUST** have an 'S' number to be eligible for entry in classes 26 – 30
Please read Rule 15 before entering. It is advised to display a Stallion Badge on their bridle.

These classes are open to both Miniature & Standard Ponies. (Entry Fee £6.00 per class)
All classes winners will receive an extra **Rosette**

RIDDEN CLASSES

22. Tack & Turnout Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Any Rider of suitable height and weight for the pony. To be judged on cleanliness of pony, tack, rider (& handler if with Leading Rein). Fitting and safety of tack etc. **Due to the Equine Flu there will be NO TOUCHING of ponies, tack or rider. This will now be judged on an observation of appearance.**

23. Novice Leading Rein Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider must have attained their 3rd birthday by the day of their class and not to have attained their 9th birthday on 1st January of year of Show. Ponies must be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle. The lead rein must be attached to the noseband only.

Novice Leading Rein – NOT to have won a 1st prize of £10.00 or more at any Show.

24. Beginners First Ridden Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider must have attained their 3rd birthday by the day of their class and not to have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January of the year of Show. Ponies must be shown in any suitable snaffle bridle. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show. A person can accompany the pony and rider but **MUST NOT** interfere with the reins unless in an emergency.

25. Pony Club Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Any Rider of suitable height and weight for the pony. To include Open Ridden, Leading Reins, Beginners First Ridden & First Ridden. This class will include 2 small tasks. This class will be split if there are sufficient entries.

This class is not Affiliated to SPS-BS and is not eligible to compete in any Championship

31. Driving Class Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over driven to an Exercise Vehicle. Open to both two and four wheeled Exercise Vehicle. To be judged on cleanliness, safety, fitting of harness and suitability of vehicle. **Junior Whip** – 8 years to 17 years old on the day of the Show and must be accompanied by a adult.

Best Driven Exhibit Rosette to the winner of the class.

Best Junior Whip Rosette awarded to the highest placed Junior.

SWSPG RULES

By entering the Show, you have agreed and accepted all these rules.

- 1) The Organisers of this Show have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone **MUST** take care to prevent accidents occurring and **MUST** obey the instructions of the Officials and Stewards.
- 2) All Exhibitors are advised to have their own Public Liability Insurance.

- 3) All vehicles are parked at the risk of the Owners and the Organisers will not be liable for any damage whatsoever or how so ever caused.
- 4) A First Aider will be in attendance, with emergency services call out.
- 5) Objections which may only be lodged by the Owner or their authorised representative must be handed to the Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the incident and must be accompanied by £20 deposit. Returnable if the objection is upheld.
- 6) No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee.
- 7) The Organisers reserve the right to limit entries and refuse entry to an exhibitor without giving a reason.
- 8) This Show is also run under the rules of the Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society (SPS-BS)
- 9) The Judge's decision is final.
- 10) All Ponies entered must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society.
Ponies full name **Must** be on the entry form
- 11) SPS-BS Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to Foals eligible for registration.
- 12) 3 years old Fillies with Foals at foot may not be shown.
- 13) All Foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the Show.
- 14) All Stallions and Colts 2 years old and over **MUST** be suitably bitted. They are also advised to display a Stallion/ Colt Bridle Badge.
- 15) IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION IN HAND OR RIDDEN CLASS AT AN AFFILIATED SHOW, ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER **MUST** HAVE AN 'S' NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPS-BS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPS-BS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION.
In Hand Classes Stallions/Colts are advised to display a Bridle Badge. All Stallions in Ridden classes **MUST** wear a Bridle Badge.
- 16) Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring.
- 17) There **Must** be no Colts or Stallions in the Young Handlers classes.
- 18) Children under 14 years old may not show Colts (excluding Foals) or Stallions in In Hand classes.
- 19) Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years old and under **MUST** wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats conforming to current British Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 20) Riders of all ages **MUST** wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats conforming to current British Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 21) Riders of Stallions **MUST** be 12 years old and over.
- 22) If a Rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring.
Rider dismounted and take no further part.
- 23) Whips and canes must not exceed 30"
- 24) Mobile phones are not permitted in the ring under any circumstance.
- 25) All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 26) For the safety of spectators, especially children, the Collecting Rings are for **EXHIBITORS ONLY.**
Please adhere to this RULE.
